CongrUUity Rules of Conduct

- C. Youth must stay with their group, under supervision of an advisor, at all times. Do not leave your group without the explicit permission of your advisor. This includes going to the restroom during structured activities.
- D. Any one member of our community is empowered and encouraged to voice their opinions, objections or concerns at any time.
